

Diver's Code of Conduct

1. I will do my best to listen and learn from my coaches.
2. I will treat my coaches, other divers, and anyone else who comes to practice or a meet with respect.
3. I will focus on diving and only diving when I am on the diving board. I will try my best to do all of my dives in the safest way possible and I trust my coaches to help me choose the best dives for me when selecting dives for meets. I promise not to argue when safety is a concern as I know that they are only looking out for my best interests.
4. If I am uncomfortable with something I am asked to do, I promise to speak up and voice my opinion. I do not have to do anything that I feel will be unsafe for me to do. I have to speak to my coach with respect and politeness, but I do not have to participate if I feel it will be unsafe for me.
5. I will not behave in any way that is considered rude or unfriendly to my teammates or to members of the other team. I will not boo, make fun of anyone, refuse to shake hands or use bad language or gestures. I will also not distract any diver from his/her diving or put anyone in an unsafe position at any time during practice or a meet.
6. I will cheer for my team and my teammates. I know that being part of a team means that everyone is important and that everyone matters. I will be polite to the other team and give them the respect that they deserve and hope that they give it back to me.

Parent/Guardian's Code of Conduct

As an adult and role model, children are influenced by my words and actions. I agree to the following both at home practices and meets and away meets:

1. I will remember that all children participate to have fun and that competition is for youth, not adults.
2. I will be respectful and courteous of others, and will support and encourage divers, officials, team representatives, and coaches through my positive actions and attitude.
3. I will recognize that meet officials are volunteers and will treat them with the same respect that I would expect if I were in that position.
4. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike behavior with an official, coach, diver, or parent/guardian such as arguing, booing, taunting, or using profane language or gestures.
5. I will not ridicule or yell at my child or any other participant.
6. I will respect and support the team representatives', officials' and coaches' authority during meets. If I have a question, I will go to the representatives after or in between meets and speak with them so that the situation can be properly addressed.
7. I will support a diving environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all team events.
8. I will respect and support the teachings of the coaches and I will give them their space. I will not enter the pool deck area during dive practices or meets (except in the spectator area) as this may interrupt training and may pose a safety hazard to the divers.
9. I promise to help my child enjoy the summer diving experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, volunteering at meets, and helping with other team activities.
