

2017 RULES and REGULATIONS

FOURS VOLLEYBALL

1. **Each match consists of four games.** All matches will be played on Wednesdays unless the Teams agree.
2. **Each game will use rally scoring to 21 points, must win by two with a cap at 25.**
3. Any serve that hits the top of the net but falls into the opponent's court is in play.
4. Players do not need to rotate positions on the court except to serve.
5. **This league is co-ed and each team must have at least one woman on the court at all times.** Matches are played with no less than 3 players and no more than 4 players on the court for each team. No "hole" is on the court when a team plays with three players. Teams are not allowed to play with two players.
6. During the regular season only, players from any team may sub for other teams. Each team must have **at least two roster players on the court at all times** and a minimum of three players. Subs are not allowed during the playoffs.
7. **Rosters are due to the commissioner by July 9th with the participation fee of \$10.00 for each player on the roster. Parental Permission forms are due by June 18th.** Players may be added to the roster up until August 20th.
8. All league games must start at scheduled time or 15 minutes after end of preceding match, whichever is later. A game is forfeited if a team does not have enough players to start a match by 10 minutes after the designated starting time. Subsequent games are forfeited every 10 minutes thereafter.
9. In Co-ed 4's, a player can penetrate under the net provided they do not interfere with the opponent. In other leagues, this is illegal. Also new this year, kicking the ball is allowed in this league only.
10. No net contact is allowed. Although allowed in other leagues, due to the absence of referees at CSC, contact of any kind (except hair and clothing) with the net is illegal.
11. Only the top four teams will be in the playoffs. **All matches must be played by August 13th. If matches have not been completed by then, both teams will "lose" the uncompleted matches.**

Captains should make every effort to post any make-up games on the calendars on the board with as much notice as possible.
