Club member **Elizabeth Haley**, age 15, was seriously injured in a skiing accident on March 14, 2018. The accident caused multiple facial fractures, a skull fracture, and significant brain injury. She was taken to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, and was in a coma for about two weeks. She has subsequently been transferred to the Kennedy Krieger Institute in Baltimore, where she is undergoing extensive physical therapy. The therapy regimen is expected to continue for several weeks.

The Haley family is well known to many at the Swim Club. Liz's older siblings, Anna, Ben, Chris, and Danielle are, or were, among our best known and liked life guards, and Elizabeth had just completed life safety training in order to join the guard team.

Liz's mother, Sharon, spends most of her days and night with Liz, and has made regular journal entries on the Caring Bridge website to document Liz's treatment and therapy.
