2010 Volleyball Registration & Rules

*It is the policy of the Calverton Swim Club that all members, regardless of ability, have the opportunity to participate in the CSC volleyball leagues. Players have the option to form a team or to ask to be placed on a team. Players interested in joining a team should contact the League Commissioners. Any team participating in a CSC volleyball league is required to add new players upon the request of the League Commissioner.*

1. League play begins on June 16 and ends on August 6. League champions will be determined by the best win/loss record. Playoffs begin August 13. Playoffs will consist of a single or double elimination tournament, depending on the league. All teams participate in the playoffs.
2. All players and subs must be pool members, age 14 and older by 12/31/10.
3. ***The registration fee is \$8 per person per league.*** It is the responsibility of the team captain to turn rosters and fees into the league commissioner. **Rosters are due by June 27. Fees are due by July 18. Any team not having paid by July 18 can be removed from the league.** A volleyball mailbox is located in the pool office.
4. During the regular season only, players from any team are allowed to sub for other teams. Women are allowed to sub for men's teams in the regular season. Teams are encouraged to use subs on the sub list first.
5. To participate in the playoffs a player must be on a team roster and have paid a registration fee. Players may be added to a roster up until August 10.
6. For 6's, teams must have a minimum of four players, including two roster players, to play a match. For coed 6's, no team shall play with more than three men or less than two women. For 4's teams must have a minimum of three players, including one roster player to play a match. For 4's, no team shall play with less than one women. No more than three subs may be used in a match.
7. Every effort must be made to play matches as scheduled, weather permitting. Any team captain wishing to reschedule a match must contact the opposing team captain prior to the day of the game. It is the responsibility of the team captain that canceled the game to reschedule. If the match cannot be rescheduled the team that cancelled forfeit's the match. All games must be completed by August 10. **There will be no rescheduling of playoff games unless weather related.**
8. Cancellation or postponement of games due to weather conditions should be determined by the team captains. Matches will not be played if standing water is present on the court. All volleyball courts will be cleared if the pool is closed due to lightening.
9. All league games must start at scheduled time or 15 minutes after end of preceding match, whichever is later. A game is forfeited, if a team does not have enough players to start a match by 10 minutes after the designated starting time. Subsequent games are forfeited every 10 minutes thereafter.

10. Any team forfeiting two matches during regular league play will not be eligible for the playoffs.
11. It is the responsibility of the team captains to post the results of the match on the same day they are played. Rescheduled matches should also be identified on the league schedule.
12. All games (in all leagues) will be rally scoring format to 25 points. Every serve results in a point.
13. All games have a “cap” of 30 points.
14. Teams may rotate or sub players in, but not both, except in case of injury.
15. Each team is allowed, three (two minute) time-outs per game.
16. **Making contact with the opponent’s court – completely across the imaginary line under the net - with any part of the body is illegal in 6’s play. In 4’s you can penetrate under the net provided you do not interfere with the opponent.**
17. In coed, bringing a man up from the back row to block is illegal.
18. Open-handed contact is allowed when receiving the ball. “Carrying” the ball is not allowed. Honor calls are expected among competitors. Team captains are responsible for making appropriate calls.
19. Serves hitting the net and going over are in play. Once the ball is tossed for a serve it must be played. Failure to serve will result in a sideout and loss of point.
20. Should a team not have six players at the start of the game:
  - Men’s and Women’s - the team must play with a “hole” at serve only.
  - **Coed – the team must play the “hole” by position and rotate accordingly. This rule change is being made to avoid the advantage of a team with three men and two women gaining an advantage by having two men in the front for 5 of 6 rotations.**
21. During playoffs, the “if” game which may be played in the championship match to determine the winner, will be 1 game to 15 points rally scoring and must be won by 2 points (with no cap).
22. **Posts act as antenna for all purposes except player contact.**
