2018 Volleyball Registration & Rules

It is the policy of the Calverton Swim Club that all members, regardless of ability, have the opportunity to participate in the CSC volleyball leagues. Players have the option to form a team or to ask to be placed on a team. Players interested in joining a team should contact the League Commissioners. Any team participating in the CSC Volleyball League is required to add new players upon the request of the League Commissioner.

1. League play begins on June 8 and ends on August 19. League champions will be determined by the best win/loss record. Playoffs will consist of a single elimination tournament involving the top four teams. All ties will be broken by head-to-head records among the teams tied. If a second tiebreaker is needed for seeding or to determine who gets into the playoffs, a coin flip will be used.

2. All players and subs must be pool members, age 14 and older by 12/31/18. **All players under the age of 18 as of 6/1/18 must have a signed parental permission form to play.**

3. ***The registration fee is \$10 per person per league.*** It is the responsibility of the team captain to turn rosters, parental permission forms, and fees into the league commissioner. **Parental permission forms are due by June 17. Rosters and fees are due by July 15.** Any team not having paid by July 15 can be removed from the league.

4. During the regular season only, players from any team are allowed to sub for other teams. Women are allowed to sub for men's teams in the regular season.

5. To participate in the playoffs a player must be on a team roster and have paid a registration fee. **Players may be added to a roster up until August 19.**

6. Every effort must be made to play matches as scheduled, weather permitting. Any team captain wishing to reschedule a match must contact the opposing team captain prior to the day of the game. It is the responsibility of the team captain that canceled the game to reschedule. If the match cannot be rescheduled the team that cancelled forfeits the match. All games must be completed by August 19. **There will be no rescheduling of playoff games unless weather related.**

7. League play (regularly scheduled or make up) takes priority over open/pickup play. Regularly scheduled games are posted on the volleyball corkboard. Make up games: Captains should make every effort to post these games on the calendars on the board with as much notice as possible.

8. Cancellation or postponement of games due to weather conditions should be determined by the team captains. Matches will not be played if standing water is present on the court. All volleyball courts will be cleared if the pool is closed due to lightning.

9. All league games must start at scheduled time or 15 minutes after end of preceding match, whichever is later. A game is forfeited, if a team does not have enough players to start a match by 10 minutes after the designated starting time. Subsequent games are forfeited every 10 minutes thereafter.
10. Any team forfeiting two matches during league play will not be eligible for the playoffs.
11. It is the responsibility of the team captains to post the results of the match on the same day they are played. Rescheduled matches should also be identified on the league schedule.
12. All games (in all leagues) will be rally scoring format to 25 points.
13. All games have a “cap” of 30 points.
14. Posts act as antenna for all purposes, except player contact.
15. Teams may rotate or sub players in, but not both, except in case of injury.
16. Each team is allowed, two (two minute) time-outs per game.
17. Making contact with the opponent’s court – completely across the imaginary line under the net - with any part of the body is illegal in 6’s play. In doubles and 4’s you can penetrate under the net provided you do not interfere with an opposing player.
18. No net contact is allowed except incidental contact with hair and clothing.
19. No kicking of the ball is allowed, except in doubles and 4’s.
20. Open-handed contact is allowed when receiving the ball, except in doubles. “Carrying” the ball is not allowed. Honor calls are expected among competitors. Team captains are responsible for making appropriate calls.
21. Serves hitting the net and going over are in play, except in doubles. Once the ball is tossed it must be played. Failure to serve will result in a side-out and loss of point.
22. For Coed 6's, teams must have a minimum of four players, including two roster players. For Coed 6's, no team shall play with more than three men or less than two women. For Women’s, Men’s and Coed 4's teams must have a minimum of three players, including two roster players to play a match. For 4's, no team shall play with less than one woman.
23. Should a team not have six players at the start of a game:
 - Women’s – can play with 5 players without handicap, 4 players require 1 “hole” lost as serve. There is no position requirement when playing with 4 players.
 - Men’s – can play with 4-6 players without handicap. Each player under 4 requires a “hole” lost as serve.
 - Coed – the “hole” must be played by position and rotate accordingly.
